The Vision of Homescholars Academy is to honor God and strengthen families by sharing educational experiences and ideas, to inspire confidence in our kids and in their ability to become life-long learners, and to assist these young thinkers in becoming stewards of their own personal mission and education.

Moral Conduct Standards

All Homescholars Academy members age(s) eight and above must read (or be read to), understand, and agree to abide by these standards:

Behavior: I agree to act as a gentleman or lady and treat others with respect, kindness, and encouragement in speech and action as I demonstrate integrity and Christian values. I will refrain from any expression, gossip or physical contact that may harm or make another feel uncomfortable. I will not bring anything to Homescholars Academy classes that is considered a weapon or could bring insult or injury to another member. In addition, pairing off with the opposite sex, hand holding, kissing, or other affectionate gestures that sometimes accompany those who “pair off” are not allowed in this setting.

Dress and Appearance: Dress should be modest in appearance. Shorts, skirts, and dresses should be at least knee length. Clothing should not be tight, revealing, or low-cut in the front or back and it should cover the stomach and shoulders. All members should be neat and clean, and avoid being sloppy in dress, grooming, and manners.

Language: Language used at Homescholars Academy should be clean and intelligent – that which uplifts, encourages, and compliments others. The names of God and Jesus Christ should be used only in reverence. Profane, vulgar, or crude language or gestures, as well as jokes about immoral actions are not allowed.

Media: Offensive material such as movies, music, videos/DVDs, books, magazines, pictures, and other media are not allowed at Homescholars Academy. This includes anything vulgar, immoral, violent, or pornographic. Cell Phones will need to be left with an adult, as they are not allowed in class.

Service to Our Organization: As members of Homescholars Academy, we commit to serve our organization by participating in cleaning of the building, keeping our environment clean and orderly, keeping track of our own possessions, and being attentive to our family’s needs.

Rules for Safety

We want all our Member Families at Homescholars Academy to be safe. Accordingly, we have certain rules that must be followed. When you sign the Membership Agreement Form, you agree to abide by these extremely important rules:

- A Parent or Guardian must be in attendance with the child at all times. Children are not to be left alone - this is not a drop-off kind of school. Parents are welcome to attend classes with their children, help the teachers, or to stay in the parent room provided. This is a room for all parents/guardians, as well as babies or children not attending classes.
- If not in a class, children must be either with their parent or in one of the designated study/game rooms.
- Hall Monitors patrol the halls each hour. Members take turns on Hall Monitor duty, an hour at a time. Hall Monitors make sure children are where they are supposed to be, and make sure the Building Use Policy is being followed.

Frequently Asked Questions

Why do we have class on Tuesday mornings?

It works best for our wonderful Blackfoot Christian Fellowship that lets us meet in their building, and because it avoids conflict with lunch and nap time for the little ones.

What do we do to protect our students?

1. We have 2 teachers/adults per class, and moms are free to attend classes with their children if they would like.
2. A parent/guardian is required to be on the premises with their children at all times.

Can I drop off my kids and run some errands?

No. This is part of the protection for our students. We are a co-op for families. This is a family environment, where parents and children can learn together.

Do you require a statement of faith?

We are open to members of all faiths. We have the understanding in our group that God is freely discussed in class and in the building and that we are all respectful of each others' religions. We do not require any kind of statement of faith.

Do I have to help?

We ask that all moms take turns teaching and/or helping with a class at least once a year. We understand that sometimes circumstances, such as having a new baby, make it hard to teach sometimes. In this case, there are plenty of other opportunities to volunteer and help, such as planning mom's nights, helping with the semester showcases, etc.

If you have toddlers that need watching while you're teaching, there are generally moms willing to watch them for you, especially if you watch theirs while they are teaching. Don't assume that someone will just be there to watch them, however. Make sure you make arrangements first.

What homeschool style do you follow?

We do not follow any specific homeschool methodology—TJed, Charlotte Mason, Classical Conversations, etc. We are eclectic in our teaching approaches and content.
